



WINEMAKING

This wine is created to be approachable and enjoyable whilst young, with the typical flavours, structure and tannin one comes to expect from a Heathcote Shiraz. The 2007 shows intensity of flavours and structure that this vintage created. The grapes were harvested from two vineyards in Heathcote: Ellis Vineyards and Wildena Estate. The wine spent up to 12 months in American and French oak.

TASTING NOTES

- Colour: Bright ruby red.
Nose: Herbal notes, dark cherries and dusty oak aromas are present.
Palate: Medium weight, the wine is smooth with integrated tannins and great length of flavour. The aromas of herbs, dark cherries and oak follow through to the palate, with an intense mocha flavour adding further complexity.
